



Field Trip Grades 5-6

Dear Parents:

The Brewer game is all set to go. The tickets should arrive soon and along with the Weather Day information. I will make copies of all of the Weather Day material and send it home with the students once it arrives.

The date for the game is Wednesday, April 17th. The event begins at 9:30 AM with the game starting at 12:40 PM. The Brewers are playing the St. Louis Cardinals. This should be a great educational experience for the students.

Tickets are \$20 per person. Our tickets are Field Outfield Box which normally are priced at \$42 a ticket.

The members from CBS 58 would like all schools to arrive around 9:00 a.m. **That means we will need to leave at 8:00 AM!** (With the high volume of traffic around the Zoo Interchange, and also the high volume of buss traffic from all of the schools attending it may take a while to get into Miller Park)

Everyone will be able to purchase concessions at special Weather Day prices. You are allowed to bring beverages in a closed container and snack foods into the stadium. You are actually encouraged to bring lunches into the stadium for this event. However, please pay attention to the following rules:

-Plastic bottles only, no cans or glass containers. All plastic bottled drinks must be factory sealed. If the seal is opened, the item will not be allowed into the stadium.

-Please pack lunches in bags that can be disposed of after the student is finished with lunch. They will not want to be dragging a lunch box/cooler with them all day.

-Students may bring other food items in like licorice, peanuts, sunflower seeds, etc. I would recommend a backpack if they chose to bring food items.

I will allow students to bring cameras, cell phones, iPods, etc. to the game. Please note that this is done at their own risk. I will not be responsible for lost or broken items.

I expect the game to last around 3 hours. It will take approximately 1 hour to return home with traffic. I am guessing we will return around 5:00 PM. For any student not attending with their parent/guardian, I will have them call when we are nearing Johnson Creek so that you can arrive on time to pick them up from school.

We are once again taking a school bus to the event. This will eliminate the need for drivers and parking costs.

Where do I enter the ballpark?

All Weather Day participants MUST enter Miller Park through the Hot Corner (left field) or Right Field entrance. These are the only two entry points that will be open for the Weather Day presentation.

Do I sit in my ticketed seat for the Weather Day Presentation?

No, all seats for the Weather Day presentation will be on the Field and Loge levels of the stadium. This seating is first come first served, and students will be directed where to go as they arrive at Miller Park. Please listen to the ushers directions.

Will I be able to exit the ballpark after the presentation, and re-enter for the game?

No, once you have entered Miller Park for the Weather Day event, you will not be able to leave and re-enter. Please make sure you have everything you need before entering the stadium.

Are there special concession offers for Weather Day?

Yes, each Weather Day ticket purchased includes a free hotdog and bottled water. There will be designated redemption stations behind sections 105, 205, and 404. The bottom portion of your ticket stub must be turned in to receive your free hotdog and water. The redemption stations will be open beginning at 11:00am and available through the end of the 5th inning.

What are the pre-game activities available to students?

Following the CBS 58 Ready Weather Team presentation students will be able to participate in an interactive science fair hosted by AcuRite, Discovery World, the Milwaukee Public Museum, the National Weather Service, Ready Wisconsin and WE Energies. The science fair is located on the Field, Loge and Terrace Levels, in the right field corner. The science fair will be available until 12:30 pm. Also, meet the CBS 58 Ready Weather Meteorologists on the Terrace Level in the right field corner. Join in the fun! Carry-in Policy

Guests may not bring any cans, glass containers or alcohol into Miller Park. Soda, water or juice must be contained in factory-sealed plastic bottles. Guests may bring personal-size food items into Miller Park using appropriate containers. Aerosol cans (sunscreen, hairspray, etc.) are prohibited. All bags, purses, fanny packs or soft-sided coolers must conform to 16" x 16" x 8" or smaller in size and are subject to inspection. Hard-sided coolers are not allowed in the ballpark. Fans are encouraged to limit their carry-in items in the interest of expediting the entry process for all fans.

The following items are among those not permitted to be brought into Miller Park (*items are subject to change without notice*):

- Aerosol Cans (sunscreen, hairspray, etc.)
- Alcohol
- Bags/Luggage (larger than 16" x 16" x 8")
- Brooms/Broomsticks/Poles
- Cans & Glass Containers
- Hard-Sided Coolers
- Laser Pointers
- Masks
- Noise Makers
- Non-Factory Sealed Plastic Containers
- Pepper Spray
- Pets (except for service animals or during specific promotions)
- Throwing Items
- No open or concealed weapons/firearms (including pocket knives) are allowed anywhere inside Miller Park.

Weather Day Timeline

8:00am - 8:45 Arrive at Miller Park

- NOTE: IT IS IMPORTANT TO ARRIVE ON TIME TO ENSURE YOU ARE SEATED IN THE BALLPARK IN TIME FOR THE 9:30 AM PRESENTATION.
- Upon arrival, students should bring their lunches and any other items needed for the game into the stadium and take their seats for the presentation. Brewers' personnel will be on site to help direct everyone to their designated Weather Day seating areas to view the Weather Day presentation. Students should not go to the seats noted on their tickets until after the presentation and Science Fair portion of the day.

9:30am - Weather Day Program begins - presented by CBS 58 Ready Weather team

- CBS 58 Ready Weather meteorologists will give a lesson on severe weather awareness with demonstrations highlighted by video and sound effects.

11:00am - Science Fair

- Following the Weather Day presentation, bring your students to the Science Fair, located in the right-field corner on the Field, Loge and Terrace Level concourses. Enjoy exhibits from our partners:
