


What/When: Ladies Tuesday night Bible study begins September 10, at 6:30-7:45

Topic: What do you do when your reality is so different from the vision you had for yourself. In this 12-session video Bible study by Lysa TerKeurst president of Proverbs 31 Ministries and a New York Times best-selling author. She offers fresh biblical insight to how God helped guide her through painful situations that had her questioning: ***What do you do when God's timing seems questionable, His lack of intervention hurtful, and His promises doubtful?*** Life often looks so very different than we hoped or expected. Some events may simply catch us off guard for a moment, but others shatter us completely. We feel disappointed and disillusioned, and we quietly start to wonder about the reality of God's goodness.

Lysa TerKeurst understands this deeply. But she's also discovered that our disappointments can be the divine appointments our souls need to radically encounter God. In *It's Not Supposed to Be This Way*, Lysa invites us into her own journey of faith and through Bible study how she armed herself with these truths to combat the hurt of disappointment. This study includes strategies to:

- Stop being pulled into the anxiety of disappointment by discovering how to better process unmet expectations and other painful situations.
- Train ourselves to recognize the three strategies of the enemy so we can stand strong and persevere through unsettling relationships and uncertain outcomes.
- Discover the secret of being steadfast and not panicking when God seems to give us more than we can handle.
- Shift our suspicion that God is cruel or unfair to the biblical assurance that God is protecting and preparing us.
- Know how to encourage a friend and help her navigate hard realities with real help from God's truth.
