First we see the Lord raise Lazarus from the dead, and then watch as Mary of Bethany anoints Jesus in anticipation of His own burial. We stand with Mary of Nazareth and other women at the cross, and then run with Mary Magdalene as she hurries back to Jerusalem to tell the disciples, “I have seen the Lord!” Drawing from nearly forty English translations, as well as twenty commentaries and other Biblical resources. We journey with The Women of Easter, as we follow the Lord from the cross to the grave to the sky. He is risen indeed! How the chapters unfold (the titles were chosen from Easter hymns)
