The St. John's executive team met this evening for a difficult discussion about what steps to take with our ministry in the coming weeks

- **We have decided to suspend all worship services at St. John's until further notice.** We are cancelling virtually all activities at this time as we look forward to being able to resume gathering for worship. We do so out of respect for the governing authorities and the guidelines recently given in state mandates, as well as out of Christian care and concern for the well-being of our own members, and the community as a whole
- **Online worship options are being explored.** We are developing ways to share God's Word digitally through video or emailed devotions and Bible studies. Watch for more information coming soon about that. We also intend to keep showing weekly worship on local TV and radio.
